Feb 21st 1877

Francis A Walker, Esq
Dr. Sir

I found in the P. O. of this place a communicative from you to **James M. Morrow** Ast Marshal for Sub Div 107 Notifying him of the fact that he had neglected appending his certificate, according to law to Schedule Two and requesting him to return a detached certificate instead. As I once before signed the Captain's name by his authority while he was on his death bed and it was accepted I have concluded that perhaps it may not be improper for me to do so again as I am the only person that knows all about that part of his business, having assisted him in taking the Census a portion of the time and had all the Schedules copied at my house. The Capt has been dead for some time as I wrote you once before, being shot down in the streets of this place last November. I have signed his name to the certificate hoping that it will answer the purpose. If it will not do, please let me know how it can be done so as to give satisfaction and I will take a pleasure in doing anything that is right in the promises.
