The 1860 Mortality Schedule was collected in conjunction with the 1860 Population Census. It listed persons who died within the preceding year. The schedule was divided into eleven columns with the following labels: Name of Every Person who Died during the year ending 1st June 1860, whose usual place of abode at the time of death was in this family; Age; Sex; Color, white, black, or mulatto; Free or Slave; Married or widowed; Place of Birth, Naming the State, Territory or Country; The Month in which the person died; Profession, Occupation, or Trade; Disease or Cause of Death; and Number of Days Ill.
